

THE ROLE OF THE BABL PARENT ASSISTANT COACH (PAC)

We very much appreciate all the parents serving as PACs. Thank you for your time!

1. Be available for all League games and practices (or provide a qualified substitute) to assist the Koa head coach. The PAC will also read and understand the league rules.
2. Assist the Koa staff in keeping the players safe, including safety management in the dugout.
3. Keep the book (by hand or using GameChanger) or find a parent who is willing to do it.
4. Enthusiastically coach first base when your team is at bat.
5. Assist speeding up the game in the following areas: Have the catcher geared up and/or provide a courtesy runner for the catcher with two outs, have players on deck and in the hole, monitor batting order.
6. Notify the Baseball Director of any incidents within 24 hours.
7. Read and sign the Koa's Coaches Code of Conduct.
8. Assist Koa staff in making every Koa event a fun, positive, learning atmosphere for the athletes!
