

PLAYING TIME POLICY

Koa seeks to provide all student-athletes with the opportunity to have fun playing the sport they enjoy. Each player should know what it feels like to be contributing member of a team.

GENERAL

1. Parents should not discuss playing time concerns with coaches. Please refer issues to the program director. Please refer to the "24-hour rule" as noted in the code of conduct.
2. Student-athlete to coach communication is always encouraged. As it is with many things, timing and approach is everything. He is asked to actively support his teammates at all times. Student-athletes will refrain from asking coaches about playing time during games.
3. Each student-athlete will be given playing time. The exception to this statement will be disciplinary cases.
4. Players can fall from favor due to diminishing skills, lackluster energy, spotty attendance, or poor focus/attitude.
5. Koa Coaches continuously evaluate playing time.

REGULAR SEASON

1. Everyone who shows up will play, those who attend practice on a regular basis will be favored in regards to playing time.
2. Koa Select teams play to win, however winning is not our only metric of success.

TOURNAMENTS & PLAYOFFS

1. Coach has the right to tweak lineups and adjust playing time.
2. We're playing to win these games.
3. Regular season games can be treated differently than playoff games.

PLEASE NOTE:

It's easy to play Monday morning quarterback. Hindsight is 20/20. Koa Coaches are screened and trained to manage the full range of game situations if you have constructive feedback to share, then we'd love to hear it.

Player Pledge

- Koa basketball will be my sporting priority.
- I will show up on time, properly dressed, and in Koa jersey. I will come prepared for each Koa event.

- I will follow instructions from my Koa coaches. I will acknowledge my understanding verbally.
- I will let my Koa coaches handle all disagreements or disputes during the game.
- I will inform my parent(s) or Koa coaches of any physical disability or ailment that may affect me or my teammate's performance and safety.
- I will keep team areas neat by minding my belongings. Facilities should be cleaner after departure than upon arrival.
- I will help to clean up team equipment and trash after activities (before collecting my belongings).
- I will expect my attitude, practice attendance, and behavior will impact my playing time.
- If I've done my best, then I will gladly embrace my performance and the final score.

Parents/Spectator Code of Conduct

- I will not force my child to participate in sports.
- I will remember that children play to have fun.
- I will promote my child's emotional and physical well-being ahead
- I will learn the rules of the game and the policies of the Koa Sports League.
- I will cheer for all Koa players (team comes first).
- I will only use positive and encouraging language, regardless of what's happening in the game.
- I will demonstrate positive, dignified behavior that encourages team spirit - win, lose, or draw.
- I will teach my child to resolve conflicts without resorting to violence and hostility.
- I will praise my child for honesty and doing the right thing in competition.
- I will expect a sports environment that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol (and I will personally refrain from use of at Koa events).
- I will align my support with the Koa coaches to provide the best possible team experience.
- I will not offer instruction to my child or other players mid-game. My commentary will be restricted to general encouragement.
- I will not be on the sideline or on the court unless asked by Koa personnel.
- I will entrust Koa coaches to manage any dispute or disagreement during the game, whether it is with the officials or the other team.
- I will not use critical, profane, racist, or sexist language towards anyone in the facility.
- "24-Hour Rule". We ask that all commentary or feedback regarding playing time, coaches' strategy, etc. be given a 24 hour grace period before being brought to the program director.

PLEASE NOTE :

a Koa coach, representative, or official, can remove any parent or spectator from a game for his/her behavior. Refusal to comply will result in dismissal of your player. For serious and/or repeated violations, Koa's Advisory Board will use discretion to recommend suspensions. Koa's refund policy applies.
