

BABL COVID PROCEDURES

As of March 2021

Safely returning to baseball is Koa's top priority during the COVID-19 pandemic. We will constantly monitor the CDC, County, and State Guidelines to ensure the best policies and procedures. This document will supersede the current BABL rules. These policies and procedures are the brainchild of many hours in the lab; to provide the best environment for players, coaches, spectators and umpires.

COVID Procedures:

- All players, coaches, umpires, and athletes are required to fill out a daily screener (self temp check and symptom check) prior attending Koa events (practices and games)
- No high 5's, hugs, chest bumps, maintain social distancing whenever possible
- No sunflower seeds
- Mask/Face coverings are required upon arrival and departure for all participants
- Mask/Face coverings required for offense players
 - Mask/Face coverings are encouraged to be warn at all times
- Coaches and umpires will be in Masks at all times
- "Dugouts" will be extended down the left and right field fences
- Players must bring a chair (Koa will cone off individual spaces for players dugout use will be prohibited)
 - Mask/Face coverings required on sidelines
- ONLY 1 PARENT PER PLAYER MAY ATTEND GAMES-
- 1 COVID parent coach per team (to help with sanitation)
